Who Are We?

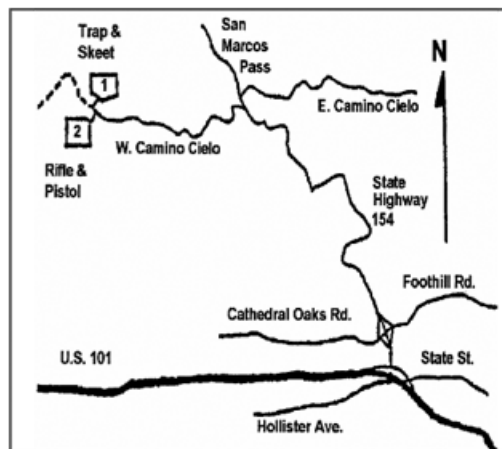

Where Are We?

The WCGC is located on West Camino Cielo northwest of Santa Barbara, California.

From US 101 N or S, Take Hwy 154 (*San Marcos Pass*). Near the crest (6.2 miles from Santa Barbara) or over the crest (12.5 miles from Solvang) take West Camino Cielo Rd. for 5.0 miles to the Pistol/Rifle gate (*on left*)...another 100 yards to the Clubhouse (*on right*).

Special Events

In addition to our regularly scheduled events, special events are held as the creativity of the members and published schedule permits. These are announced in the monthly bulletin.

Law Enforcement & Military

The Club allows local law enforcement and military agencies use of our facilities during the week. Usually conducted on the 200 yard range, such use must be exclusive, and the members are not allowed to use the range while it is being used by law enforcement or the military. This use is published in advance.



Spectators & Guests...Welcome!

The WCGC is a popular attraction for wine-country visitors, off-road and jeep groups, scouting, military, firearm industry experts, service clubs, shooting-sports observers and elected representatives from around the world. Our Range Rules and insurance requires that everyone, including spectators, wear hearing and eye protection while near any "live fire" event or activity. All children must be under the direct supervision of an adult. Please keep pets away from all shooting areas. Never touch any unattended firearm without permission.

Handicapped Shooters

The Club strongly encourages handicapped persons to shoot in the various venues. There is No Charge for a handicapped person at any range/field/event.



Youth Shooters

The Club actively promotes and teaches gun safety and marksmanship to interested youth. Youth shoot.

Shooters 17 & younger - must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult at all times and must sign a waiver before they can shoot.

Shooters 20 & younger - must be accompanied by a PARENT in order to shoot a handgun. State law is very specific and only a PARENT can allow a person 20 and younger to shoot a handgun. *This law does not apply to rifle or shotgun.*

All youth on Club premises, whether shooting or not, must be under the supervision of an adult. Neither the Trapmaster nor Rangemaster will act as the supervising adult.

Club Facilities

A clubhouse, plenty of parking, large BBQ pit, kitchen, refrigerator & stove, and restrooms. On weekends we have picnic benches and umbrellas.

Shotgun Venues

3 Trap Fields and World Class Skeet Field. Adjacent to Trap #1 is an area for shotgun training, youth instruction, and hunter education.

Rifle Ranges—100 yard & 200 yard

100 yd - our covered firing line will accommodate 11 positions for high power rifle and 15 positions for small bore.

200 yd - This area for long-range rifle is utilized for I.D.P.A., youth, and special shooting events on weekends, but is open to members during the week. Do not cross "marked" areas along east side. *See Range Rules for details.*

20 Position Pistol Range

This covered firing line is very popular with local families, reloaders, and competitive shooters.

Membership

If you shoot regularly, join the Club to maximize your shooting opportunities and value! Membership is open to anyone who: 1) is a legal resident of the United States; 2) supports the Constitution; 3) has never been convicted of a crime of violence involving a firearm or other weapon; and 4) is legally qualified to own or possess a firearm in the State of California.

Member Benefits

One of the greatest benefits is access during the times when the Club is not open to the public. Members also enjoy the following privileges:

- Use of a safe, controlled space from sunrise to sunset, seven days a week.
- Reduced shooting fees when the Club is open to the public.
- Annual Events Calendar—listing dates/times for all events.
- Monthly Newsletter—updates on events, results and scores from matches, critical club news, and more.
- Young Shooters & Students Rates—24 yrs and younger and students receive substantial discount off regular rates.
- Life Memberships—A limited number are available for a one-time fee.
